



SPRAY SCHEDULE FOR WALNUTS

TIME	PROBLEM	PRODUCT
Delayed dormant stage: when just a little green color is showing in buds.	San Jose scale, aphid eggs, mites, Lecanium scale	Horticultural oil spray
Pre-bloom stage: when the catkins are partially expanded Spring after leaves are out Summer	Walnut blight	Copper sprays. Repeat once more after bloom
	Aphids, mites	Insecticidal soaps as needed
	Walnut Husk Fly	Use walnut husk fly traps to time sprays. Use malathion 10 days after catching adults (early to mid-August). Do not apply after husks split. May be necessary to apply again 3 or 4 weeks later but do not apply more than twice during growing season.
	Aphids, mites	Insecticidal soaps as needed
