



## ROSE CULTIVARS AND DISEASE RESISTANCE

The fungal diseases of rust, powdery mildew and blackspot are common in rose gardens in the Inland Northwest. Gardeners should buy and plant varieties resistant to these diseases whenever possible. Look for plants that are certified to be disease resistant.
