



PREPARING PERENNIALS FOR WINTER

Remove all flower stalks from these perennials, but let foliage at the base remain:

Achillea (Yellow)	Coreopsis	Pyrethrum (Painted daisies)
Anchusa (Bugloss)	Delphinium	Rudbeckia (Coneflower)
Anemone	Digitalis (Foxglove)	Scabiosa
Anthemis (Chamomile)	Doronicum (Leopard's Bane)	Shasta Daisy

Remove all growth from these:

Do not touch the following:

Alyssum (Basket-of-Gold)	Ferns	Papaver (Poppies)
Aquilegia (Columbine)	Gallium odoratum (Sweet Woodruff)	Phlox subulata (Creeping Phlox)
Arabis (Rock Cress)	Hedera (English Ivy)	Plumbago (Leadwort)
Armeria (Thrift)	Helianthemum (Rock Rose)	Primula (Primrose)
Aubrieta (False Rock Cress)	Iberis (Candytuft)	Saxifraga
Carnation (hardy)	Myosotis (Forget-me-not)	Sedum (Stonecrop)
Cerastium	Nepeta (Catnip, Catmint)	Trollius (Globeflower)
Dianthus (Pinks)		Vinca (Periwinkle)

Hosta - Remove outer leaves but let inner leaves remain.

Iris, Bearded - Cut back to six inches

Daylilies - Remove flower shoots and cut foliage down to six inches
